Mount Magnet Presbyterian Church

God has been so merciful and gracious to us in all aspects of these ministries he has entrusted into our care. Currently we have 10-12 adults attending the church. These numbers vary every Sunday. We have two young families with three kids each but one of them don't come very often, we maintain our relationship with them but don't want to push. We have two couples with no kids but very faithful in attending the church. We have a couple who has trucking business in Perth so they come whenever they are in

Mount Magnet. Two gentlemen come regularly one of which is single older gentleman. We have our neighbour coming to church who has been badly hurt by the pastors in the past, but he feels comfortable enough to come.

Mount Magnet Presbyterian Sunday School

We have a bunch of Aboriginal kids coming to our church service but they cannot sit still for very long and so they talk, giggle and disturb during service so we thought to start Sunday school for them. So far so good but sometimes these kids just don't show up at all and then all of a sudden they are there.

There are 6-10 children (6-7 Aboriginal) attending Sunday School. These numbers also vary every Sunday. These children are all local who belong to parents who are working in the schools or other businesses in the town. This is an experiment to see if the kids are interested in Sunday school, we'll see how it goes.

Often I get a very good reception from Station owners, they like to talk and some of the times I get invited for coffee or tea and sometimes even for a lunch. Yet another times get given eggs or pickle jars to take home with me.

I only go out for a day visit at a time due to my young family and other commitments in the town such as two days Chaplaincy in the local district high School

Chaplaincy Ministry

Being a chaplain in the local district high School has given me a great footing and advertising in the local community which has been a great blessing for the Church and Sunday School ministry. Slowly but steadily we are building relationships with local people.

When I first started chaplaincy work in the School I didn't even get a good morning back from the older Aboriginals at the Schools, but once an older Aboriginal lady was caring her chair to the Oval and I asked if I could carry it for her, and I did, after that I not only got a good morning back from all of them but also smiles. Now by the grace of God they even involve me in their conversations.

At the School at 8 am we have a breakfast Club in which I help serve the kids and help the ladies to clean up at the end as well, even though I am not required to do any of those things, but I have found that a good use of the gift of service which God has given me is proving to be very effective.
