- Overseas short-term training seminars
- Australian Indigenous ministry resourcing



Resource

APWM seeks to provide support so that national Christians can carry out ministry themselves. This takes place through providing resources such as:

- Bibles & theological resources
- Upgrades & repairs to buildings
- Disaster relief
- · Ministry materials for pastors
- Financial assistance for Presbyterian Partner Churches in hardship.
